

## Notes of Meeting with Michelle Gardiner, RCCE on 1 October 2018

Actions Needed to progress our NDP:

1	SWAT Analysis bases on answers to our questionnaire.
2	Link each point of our Vision to one or more Objectives.
3	Every Objective needs evidence, usually from two sources: a) opinions collected by community engagement b) documentation already produced about Planning Law, NHS Statistics, Education Needs RCCE and Jenny Robinson can help us with b)
4	Engage community sectors not reached by the Questionnaire e.g. WI, Scouts, Brownies, sports team, school. Their opinion counts if they use the facilities of the village. Different ways of communication will be needed – RCCE can help with this. NOTE: the vicar of St Andrews is a School Governor, and schools usually welcome input to help them with Citizenship education. (New Head is Mr Weaver.)
5	Engagement with businesses. If they pay business rates we can find out who they are from the City Council. Individuals may work from home, so may be more difficult to reach. A business questionnaire should be designed to take into account their needs and wants, different from residents.

### General

Use the VDS to enrich the Vision.

There must be a clear link from Vision, to Objectives to Policies.  
The Vision should be stated at the beginning of Objectives and Policies.

Only Land Use Objectives can be translated into Policies (because they are Planning Policies.)

Non Land Use Objectives can be developed by Projects and Proposals.
